Kawasaki FH500V Fan Housing Screen

Midsize Models Affected: 930007, 930307

Issue

Under certain operating conditions, grass may accumulate on the rotating screen. If the screen is not cleaned from time to time, it will block the cooling airflow to the engine. This problem occurs only on the recoil starter versions.

Correction

Replace existing rotating screen with a new steel rotating screen (Kawasaki #14037-7006-9H) as per attachments.





Installation Instructions


- 1. Remove the recoil starter case by unscrewing the nuts (4 pcs.).
 - * The studs which come out of the fan housing may also be loose. If so, hold the studs with a wrench and remove only the nuts on the recoil starter case.
- 2. Remove the fan housing by unscrewing the bolts (4 pcs.).
- 3. Remove the starter pulley by unscrewing the nut.
- 4. Remove the plastic screen.
- 5. Clean debris for the cylinder, cylinder head fins and engine shroud.
- 6. Install the new metal screen (New Part No. 14037-7006-9H).
 - * Make sure that tabs on the screen and slots on the fan match together



- 7. Install the pulley.
 - * Make sure that the notches on the plate go into the holes on the pulley.



* Make sure that the direction of the washer is correct.



- * Torque the bolt to 40 ft/lbs.
- 8. Install the recoil starter case.

 Part number, enter 14037-7006-9H. Part name, enter New screen. Qty., enter 1.
- 3. Under Labor, Time in tenth of hours, enter 0.3 hrs.
- 4. Under Use this space for remarks or special data required by the factory, enter Trouble code 62 and Claim type 3.
