The Power Angle Blade is designed to be used on Steiner power units equipped with a front lift quick hitch and auxiliary hydraulic outlets. Fast, simple installation provides reliable dozing for light landscaping or snow removal. The Power Angle Blade allows the operator many choices of blade position. The blade may be power angled straight ahead, to the right or left, and any angle in between. The Manual Angle Blade allows the operator three choices of blade position. The blade may be angled straight ahead, to the right or to the left. Skid shoes are adjustable for various surface conditions to minimize cutting edge wear. The blade is equipped with safety springs for protection in the event that the blade strikes a solid object.

INSTALLATION & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Attach blade to "quick hitch" front lift in the usual manner.
- 2. Raise the "kick stand" to transport position.
- 3. **Power Angle:** Connect the hoses to the auxiliary quick couplers.

NOTE: To reverse the auxiliary hydraulic lever action, switch the hoses at the quick couplers.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Manual Angle Blade:

- 1. Remove blade and attaching parts from shipping container and place blade face down on a level floor.
- 2. See Figures 1 & 3 in the parts section for parts identification. Attach the subframe to the blade with rod and cotter pins as shown.
- 3. Hook safety trip springs over sub-frame arms and install adjusters through tabs on the blade. Tighten until about 1/2" of thread extends beyond the nut.
- 4. Install skid shoes as shown in Figure 1 using 2 bolts in each shoe and adjust as needed to minimize cutting edge wear.

Power Angle Blade:

- 1. Remove blade and attaching parts from shipping container and place blade face down on a level floor.
- 2. See Figures 1 & 2 for parts identification. Attach the subframe to the blade with rod and cotter pins as shown.
- 3. Hook safety trip springs over sub-frame arms and install adjusters through tabs on the blade. Tighten until about 1/2" of thread extends beyond the nut.
- 4. Connect hoses to the cylinder and pass them through the round hole in the side of the sub-frame. Install the blade on the tractor and hook up the hoses to the guick couplers.

NOTE: To reverse auxiliary hydraulic lever action, switch the hoses at the guick couplers.

- 5. Leveling adjustment:
 - A. Place tractor with blade installed on a level floor.
 - B. Raise blade 1" off the floor and move to straight position.
 - C. Adjust to obtain equal blade corner heights, in this position, with the two small bolts at the top of the pivot ball.
 - D. Angle blade to the extreme right position. Adjust to obtain equal blade corner heights in this position using the 5/8" bolt in the top pivot ball. Angle to the extreme left postion and check again. The ideal setting is to have the blade touch the floor equally in all postions.
- 6. Install skid shoes as shown in Figure 1 using 2 bolts in each shoe and adjust as needed to minimize cutting edge wear.

ANGLE BLADE

- The Power Angle allows the operator many choices of blade position. The blade may be power angled straight ahead, to the right or left, or any position in between.
- The Manual Angle allows the operator three choices of blade position. The blade may be angled straight ahead, to the right or left.
- 3. Skid shoes are adjustable for various surface conditions to minimize cutting edge wear.
- 4. Safety trip springs will allow the blade to trip when it hits a solid object. Provision is made to lock the safety trip device for dozing in dirt or heavy material, by inserting a 3/8 x 2" pin in a hole located near the center of the blade frame. ALWAYS remove the safety trip lock-out pin when traveling at high speeds such as during snow removal! Photo shows pin removed.



ACAUTION

Remove safety trip lock-out pin for high speed operation of blade.



1. Check skid shoes and cutting edge periodically for wear and replace the cutting edge as required to prevent wear to the main blade edge.


NOTE: Cutting edge is reversible for additional wear life.

- 2. Check safety trip and springs to assure proper operation.
- 3. Grease pivot ball at 100 hour intervals.
- 4. Keep it clean!

Power Angle Blade Leveling Adjustment

- A. Place tractor with blade installed on a level floor.
- B. Raise blade 1" off the floor and move to straight position.
- C. Adjust to obtain equal blade corner heights, in this position, with the two small bolts at the top of the pivot ball.
- D. Angle blade to the extreme right position. Adjust to obtain equal blade corner heights in this position using the 5/8" bolt in the top pivot ball. Angle to the extreme left position and check again. The ideal setting is to have the blade touch the floor equally in all positions.




