Customer Issue: The fuel tank sending unit float can become hooked on the fuel cap tether. There are certain conditions where this is more likely to occur, such as when operating on slopes and when the fuel tank is 1/4-1/2 full.

Cause: When it does become hooked, the fuel level float will remain at the same level and the fuel gage reading will not change, while the tank level drops, and eventually you run out of fuel.

Action Required: Cut 1/4" to 1/2" (no more than 1/2") out of the center of the bottom of the Tether. If it is tangled, you have to reach in the tank or use a very long tool and unhook the float before pulling out the fuel cap tether.
