
Customer Issue: We have several reports of premature failure of the drive chain after being replaced by a servicing dealer.

Cause: Incorrect installation of the master link & cotter pin during the initial repair has caused premature failure.

Action Required: Please follow the process as outlined below to properly replace the master link on the sod cutter chain.

Below are the detailed instructions on the replacement of the master link which must be followed explicitly. Failure to do so will result in another failure and void warranty reimbursement.

- 1) The clip MUST be New not reused.
- 2) The opening of the Clip MUST face the cotter pin as shown.
- 3) The clip MUST face away from clutch hub. Otherwise it will force the chain to walk off the sprocket.
- 4) Be sure the clip is fully seated in the grooves of the Master Link. Be careful not to twist or bend it upon installation.



It is essential that a NEW cotter pin be installed and bent all the way back as shown. The cotter pin breaking will cause a catastrophic failure.
